

Informed Consent Form

This is a study about the development of a mobile application for University of Winchester students who are trained to use the Television Studios. The application's primary goal will be to serve as a self-assessment method in the form of multiple hazard-perception tests, however it will also feature revision resources. It is intended for the application to be widely accessible, accommodating for a variety of disabilities including visual, hearing, motor (affecting fine movement) or cognitive (affecting memory and thinking) (Gov.uk, 2020). Your participation in this study will help to accomplish this goal.

During this usability test, you will be interacting with a prototype of the application. You will be given task(s) to complete, which will be expected of a typical end-user, and you will be observed by a facilitator while completing those tasks. You may be asked questions on your thoughts throughout the test, and will be asked to talk through your thought processes aloud.

All information collected during the usability test will be used for informing further developments of the application. Any recordings and notes may be shared with staff on the MA Digital Media Practice programme for assessment purposes, however the primary purpose of these will be for my own reflection and learning practices. All observations, recordings, and notes will be kept confidential and will not include your name. No personal information will be required during the usability test.


The usability test is a test of the mobile application, not of yourself. The intention is to learn about aspects of the application that are not yet ideal.

To the best of my knowledge, there is no physical or psychological risk associated with participating in this study. You may take breaks within the usability test as needed, and may stop your participation at any time.
